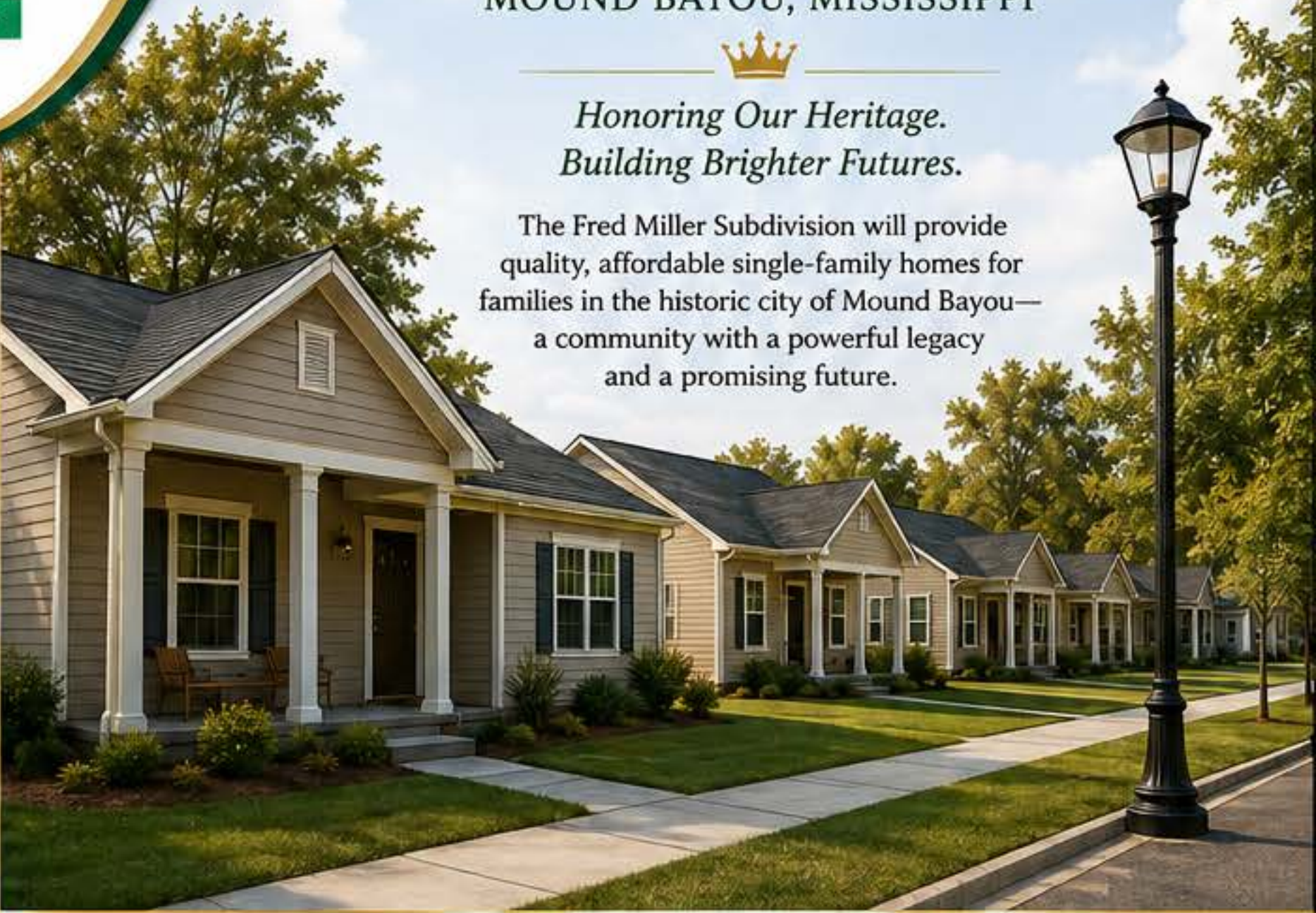


Mound Bayou City Hall, early 1900s
